


For Windows, click on windows icon download OBS software package




Depending on security settings, .exe file may detected as harmful, but it is mostly due to extension type (.exe) of the file. Click on "Keep"

Click on next




Click on Finish

Go to output, click on it




Go to recording on out put.




Change recording format to .mp4




Click Apply then click OK




Go back to internet browser, start the meeting, close all other windows




Reopen OBS and go to ADD sources, click on + mark,







Select Windows capture




Change the name if necessary.




Your Meeting windows will appear in Windows Capture, click on OK




Now your meeting ready to capture (recording), use red marks to set out put recording areas.






Click on Speaker icon and disable Mic/Aux input sound, keep only Desktop Audio enable.


**** you can monitor levels of audio from this area, change the volume if indicators going in to red zone.




Now go to start recording and click to start before the meeting.
